 - c. Review initial progress of performance vis-à-vis the division basic education plan (DEDP) intermediate outcomes on Access, Quality, and Resiliency and Well-being; and
 - d. Discuss corrective actions, prioritization of actions, and opportunities for improvement for the next quarter in terms of current policies, programs, and initiatives affecting basic education implementation for top management decisions.
- 3. Participants in this activity are the Assistant Schools Division Superintendent, Functional Division Chiefs, Education Program Supervisors, Accountant, Budget Officer, Division Testing Coordinator, Division DRRM Coordinator, SEPS-SMMES, EPS2-SMMES, District Heads, and 1 QATAME member per District.
- 4. District Heads are enjoined to prepare a **20-minute PowerPoint presentation** following the contents specified in enclosure 1. A 20-minute interpellation and discussion with the facilitating team shall follow to commend major accomplishments and clarify issues and concerns for SDO action and/or endorsement for RO decision. The facilitator assigned shall keep track of the time as the presentation is being done and shall politely cut the presentation if it exceeds the prescribed time.
