

IMPLEMENTATION OF SCHOOL-BASED FEEDING PROGRAM FOR SY

2023-2024 To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent

- Pursuant to OUOPS Memorandum No. 2023-03-3656 re Advisory for the 1. Implementation of the School-Based Feeding Program for SY 2023-2024, DepEd Order (DO) No. 031, s. 2021 re Operational Guidelines on the Implementation of the School-Based Feeding Program, DO 10, s. 2022 re Supplemental Guidelines on DepEd Order No. 031, s. 2021 and DO 38, s. 2022 re Supplemental Guidelines No. 2 to DepEd Order No. 031, s. 2021, the Department of Education through the Bureau of Learner Support Services - School Health Division (BLSS-SHD) maintains its commitment to providing good nutrition to learners by strengthening the implementation of the School-Based Feeding Program (SBFP).
- 2. The BLSS-SHD has allotted funds for the procurement of ingredients for Hot Meals intended for 23 Central Schools and Nutritious Food Products for 264 schools, and for the Operational Expenses of all 287 beneficiary schools in this Division for 120 feeding days. In this regard, the beneficiary schools may begin the implementation of the program on October 16, 2023, or as soon as the funds are available for school procurement.
- For the smooth and proper implementation of the program, the School Governance and Operations Division - School Health Section enjoins all concerned schoolheads to organize an SBFP Core Group. Its members may be selected from the school personnel (SBFP coordinator, his or her alternate, property custodian, or as designated by the schoolhead) and/or parents who shall be responsible for managing and implementing the program. The SBFP Core Group members may be replaced only for valid reasons.
- 4. To ensure that the parents/guardians of the learner-beneficiaries are aware of their roles and responsibilities, the SBFP TWG of schools shall conduct an orientation before implementing the program.
- Enclosed are the Unified Cycle Menu, Change of Menu Justification Form, and the list of school beneficiaries for Hot Meals and Nutritious Food Products for easy reference.

- 1. In case of unavailability of the planned menu, the following should be observed:
 - a. On Tuesday only the flavors can be changed but still the Nutri-packs must be distributed.
 - b. On Wednesday any Enriched Bread or Enriched Cookies only can serve as a replacement for the specified menu.
 - c. On Thursday any Fruit or Root Crop Chips only can serve as a replacement for the specified chips.
 - d. On Friday vegetable-enriched/fruit-enriched/meat bread/enriched cookies, fruit chips or juice, boiled root crop or chips, and other kinds of Nutri-packs can be substituted to the specified menu with the same price as the Nutritious Food Products.
- 2. The Enhanced Nutribun (E-Bun) to be distributed on Mondays are DOST-FNRI-approved products. There must be an imprinted "DepEd" sign per pack with its Nutritional Facts and, if possible, with a "Not For Sale" label. The distribution day of the E-Buns can be changed to another day of the week depending on the supplier's schedule of delivery (i.e. if the schedule of delivery is on Tuesday, the E-Buns must be distributed every Tuesday and the Nutri-packs on Monday).
- 3. The remaining amount from the budget of the Nutritious Food Products should be purchased with fruit juices or any other Nutritious Food Products.
- 4. Nutritious Food Products should be individually packed at exactly 60, 120, or 160gms (as stated in the cycle menu) per day for hygienic distribution and proper food handling.
- 5. Should there be any changes and additional NFPs on the menu, please fill out the Change of Menu and Justification Form (SBFP-NFP Form B 2020) and submit the same to the District Nurse for approval. This form should be attached to the liquidation as well as the DOST-FNRI Certificate and Work and Financial Plan.
