PARTICIPATION TO THE DEPED SOCCSKSARGEN REGIONAL CLIMATE CHANGE  
CARAVAN 2024

1. Pursuant to Memorandum DM-OUOPS-2024-04-03014 Supplemental Guidelines on the Utilization of the FY 2024 Disaster Preparedness and Response Program (DPRP) Funds for the Implementation of the Regional Climate Change Caravan (RCCC) and Manila Bay Rehabilitation (MBR) and Regional Memorandum ESSD-2024-144, this office will participate the conduct of the DepEd SOCCSKSARGEN Regional Climate Change Caravan activities on Oct 3-5, 2024.

2. This year's localized activity for the RCCC is dubbed Cultivating Youth Leadership for Climate Change Resilience and is anchored on the theme: "Empowering Young Leaders: Building Resilience in a Changing Climate". 7. Each SDO shall only have one entry for Draw and Tell Poster Making Contest which will be held on October 3, 2024 at Koronadal City. The Division DRRM Coordinator shall choose the participant composed of one (1) Elementary participant for Draw and Tell Poster Making Contest, each entry is allowed to have one coach who will serve also as their chaperone.

Expenses incurred for the conduct of RCCC activities such as but not limited to: a) meals and snacks, materials and supplies necessary for the conduct of RCCC; b) Tokens and honorarium of resource persons and judges; c) Prizes of RCCC 2024 contests; d) Procurement/reproduction of Climate Change Advocacy materials/ supplies; and e) other expenses indispensable for the conduct of the



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RCCC 2024 shall be charged to DRRM FY 2024 DPRP Fund while transportation and other incidental expenses of participants , TWG and facilitators shall be charged to their respective local funds, DRRM funds and other applicable fund sources, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
