1. The Department of Education – Schools Division of Sarangani will conduct a two-day-live-in **Special Management Committee Meeting** at Greenleaf Hotel, General Santos City. The meeting will be organized by batch according to the following schedule and assigned municipalities:

- a. November 4 and 5, 2024 – Batch 1 (Malungon and Maitum)
- b. November 7 and 8, 2024 – Batch 2 (Maasim, Kiamba, and Malapatan)
- c. November 11 and 12, 2024 – Batch 3 (Alabel and Glan)

2. The following are the objectives of the activity:

- a. To provide clear and accurate information on the processes, programs, projects, and activities;
- b. To align school heads with current SDO priorities and strategies for the effective implementation of curriculum and governance initiatives; and
- c. To foster collaboration and shared understanding among school leaders for the continuous improvement of school management and operations.

3. Enclosed are the activity matrix and list of participants for easy reference. Attendance of all School Heads is mandatory. Proxy representation is discouraged; however, if unavoidable due to equally important commitments, School Heads must designate the Assistant Head or Officer-in-Charge to attend. A formal letter of justification must be submitted in such cases.

4. Non-teaching personnel who render services during weekends or holidays in connection with this activity will be eligible for compensatory time off in accordance with existing rules and regulations stipulated in CSC and DBM Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004.

5. Expenses relative to the conduct of the said activity shall be charged against local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
